Please note that Club fees are now due and payable immediately.

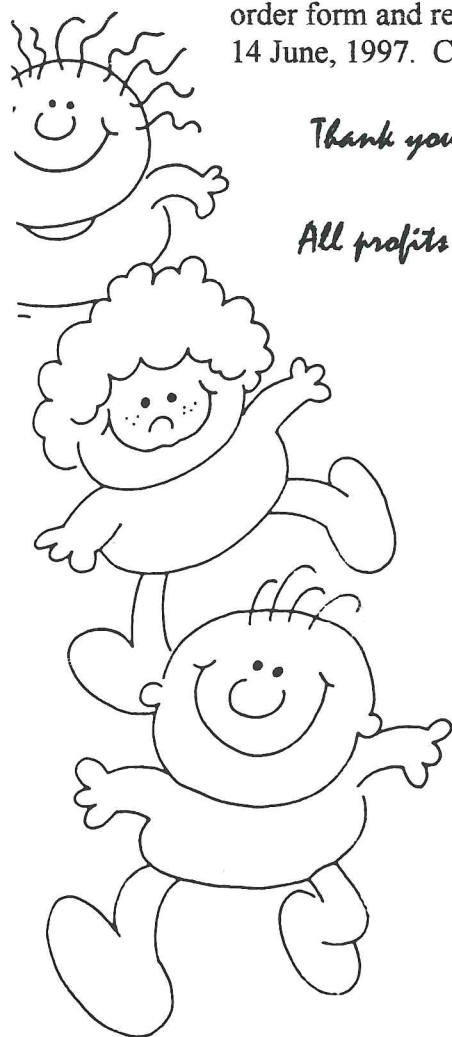
Seniors \$71.00 including \$26 VNA Levy;

Round 7 was our best win this season coming from 5 down at 1/4 time to be 5 up at 1/2 time and eventually winning the game against the team holding second position on the ladder.

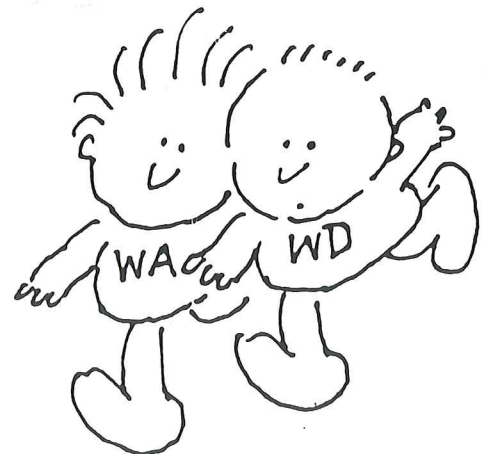
A well deserved win by the girls.

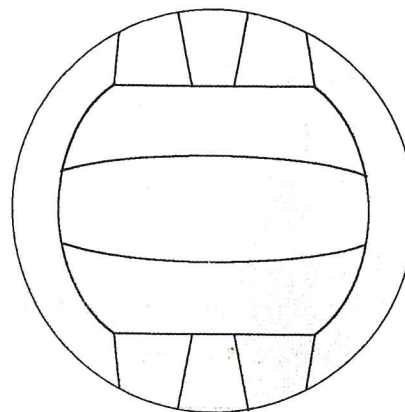
