

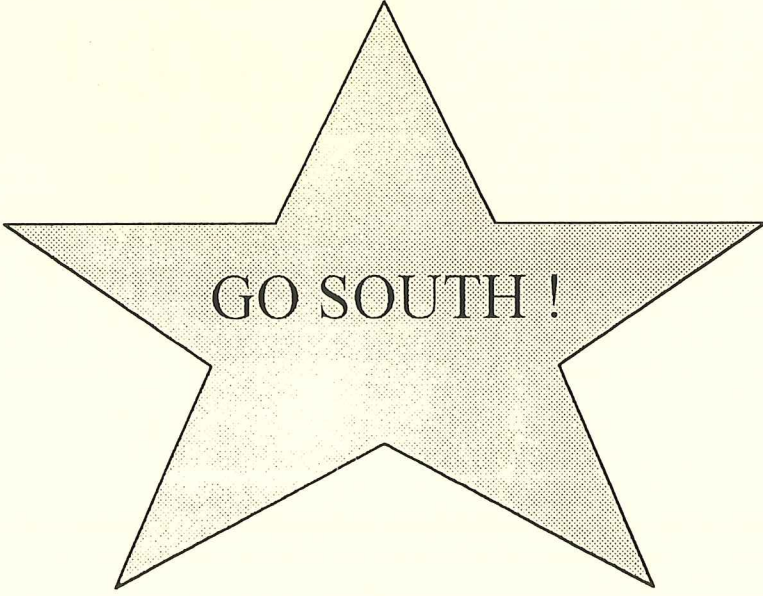

### **Indoor Tournament - 19/7/97**

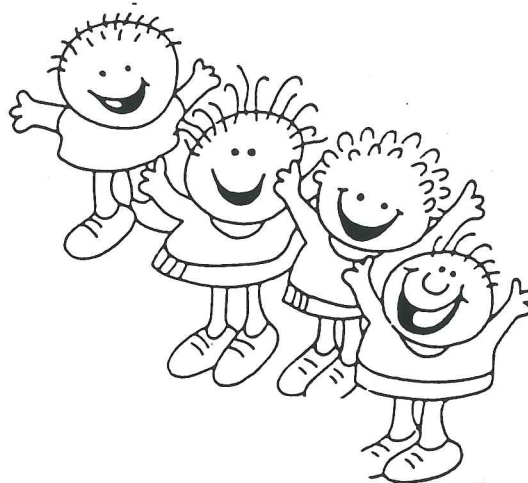
At the recent Indoor Tournament, these girls "conned" me into letting them do at the last minute, I sensed an enjoyable time was had by all.

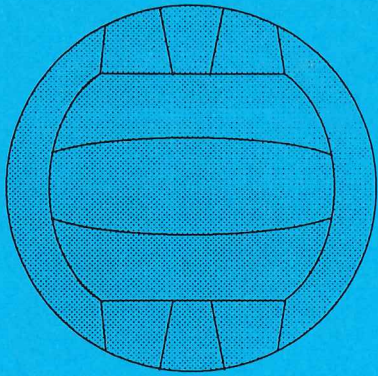
A great learning experience for these girls (I hope) coming Runners Up to Knoxfield in the Grand Final.

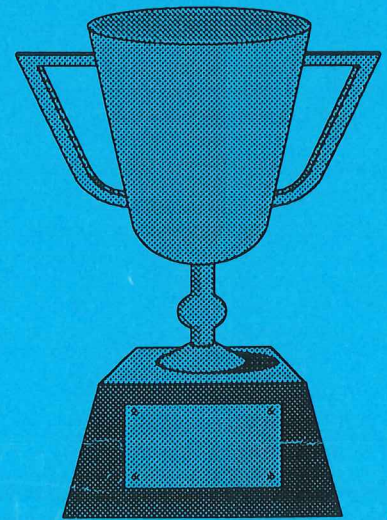

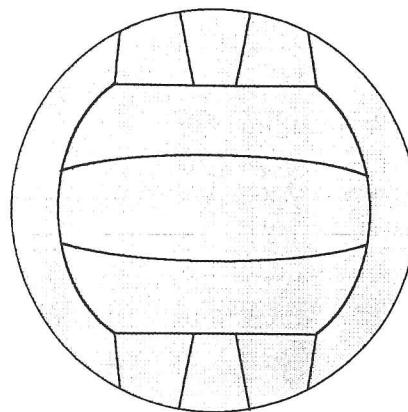
