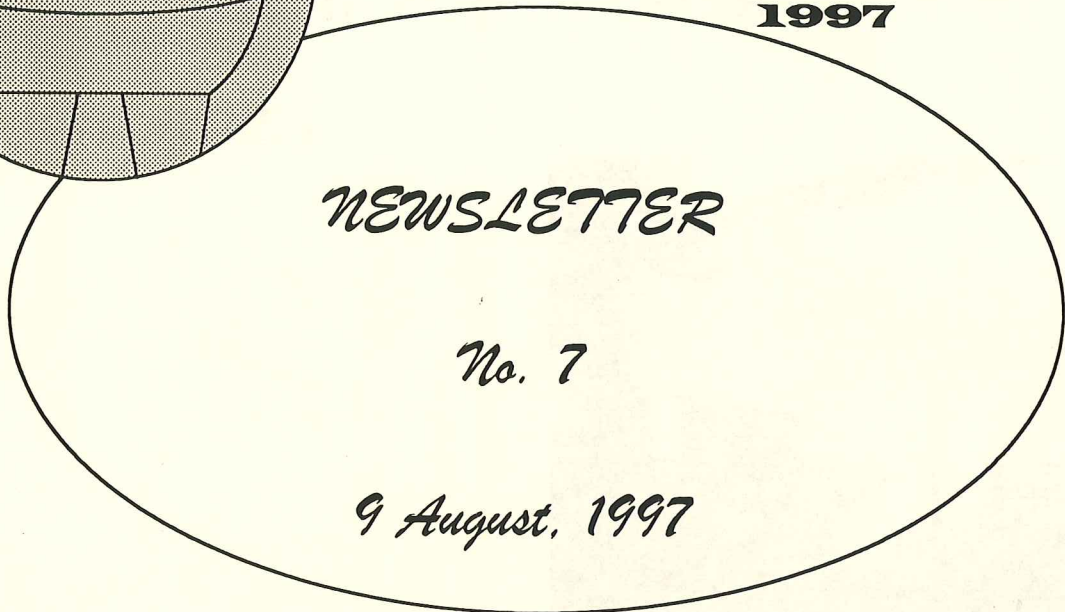

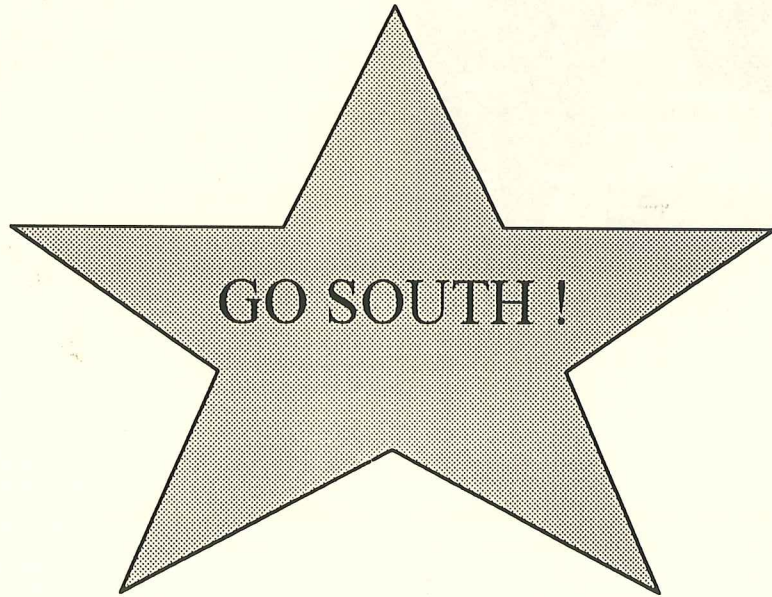

Please take careful note of the times as some of them vary to the times you have been playing on Saturdays. I would also suggest that you listen to your coach who will tell you what time they expect you to be there.

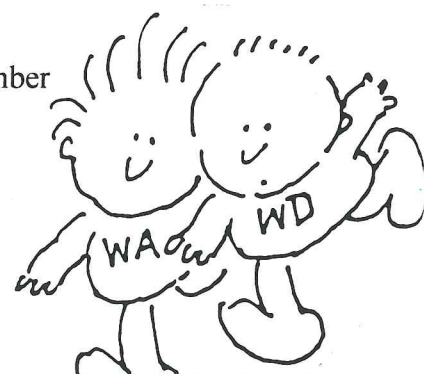

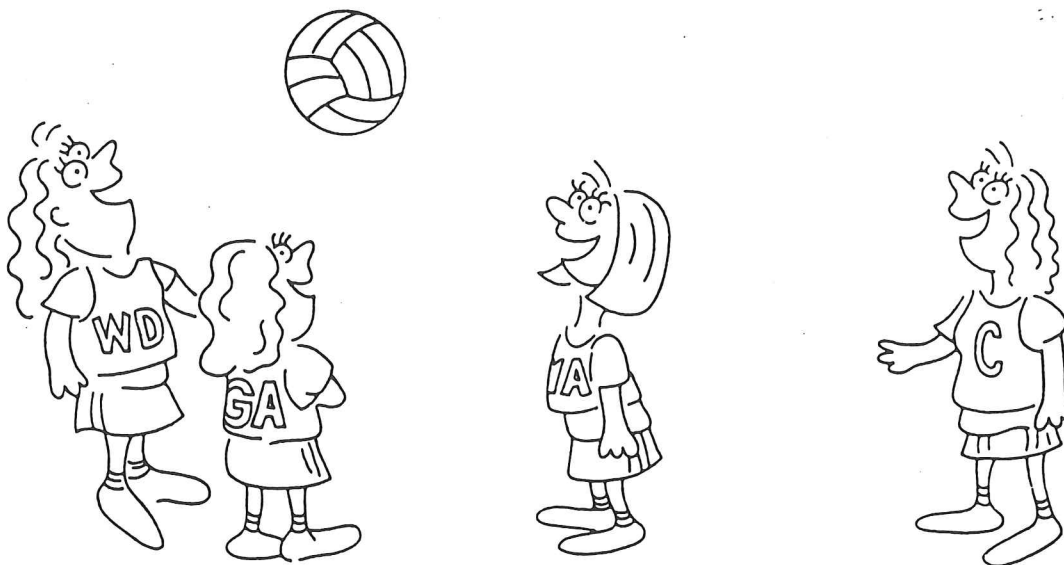
It has, and will, make my job a whole lot easier. And is really appreciated.

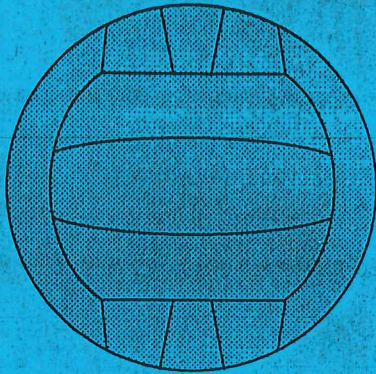
Since the last newsletter we have only played one game - a win over South Upwey by 15 goals. Wantirna South 44 to 29.

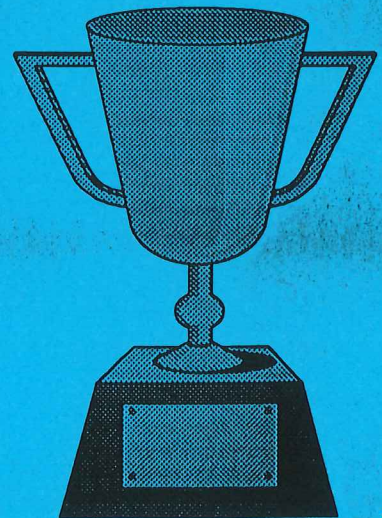

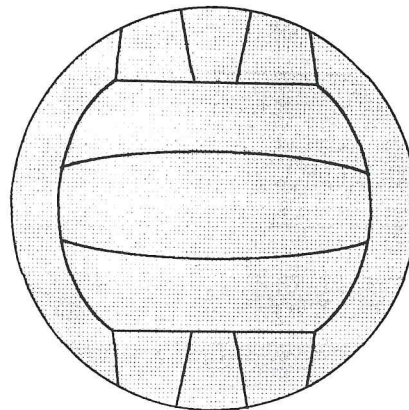
