In this issue, we have a chat with Linda Wilde, and Nicole Anderiessen.

Linda became a Life Members of WSNC in 1996, one of only two to be awarded. She's done nearly everything at our Club over the years, and is now coach of the U13 Pearls.

How long have you been with WSNC? Since 1990, about 15 years.

What roles have you filled in that time? Umpire, Umpire's Convenor & coach (all at the same time!), President for 3 years, and a committee member in various roles. I've coached teams from Netta level through to Open age.

When did you start playing netball? I started when I was young and played into my late teens. Then I played with St. Luke's Mothers Club, and various work teams for a long time.

Are you still playing? If not, why not?
No – the mind is willing but the body isn't!

What's your overall philosophy on playing / coaching? First – have fun. Base your game on solid skills, and above all else be a team player, rather than play an individual game.

What's your greatest netball achievement?

Developing my two daughters into good netballers with the right attitude; and coaching an U11 team to a Premiership in 1996.


What's your biggest netball disappointment? Don't have one – I've enjoyed it all.

What makes you proud to belong to WSNC?

It hasn't been a Club that has gone out to win at all costs, we haven't poached players as some clubs have. Also we have embraced everyone who wanted to play, there's always a position at whatever level a child can play at.

What, if anything, would you change? I would probably prefer for the season to start later and have fewer breaks. The three week break at the beginning of each Winter season makes it very hard for continuity, and makes a long season only longer.

Do you have a message to existing players? Yes, just enjoy it! Be team players, and play the game in a sportsman-like way.



Nicole has been selected by the Central Eastern Zone Training Academy this year. She is one of only two MDNA players to be selected, a great achievement.

How long have you been with WSNC? About 8 years.

What roles have you filled in that time?

As well as playing, I've been umpiring for the last 2 years. I've also represented WSNC in MDNA representative teams.

When did you start playing netball?

When I was about 7. I had one year at Studfield Netball Club before joining WSNC.

Which team are you currently playing with? The U17 – 1 Crystals.

What's your overall philosophy on playing?

Play every game as well as you can, help your teammates, and have fun.

What's your greatest netball achievement?

Being selected this year for the Zone Academy. There were 85 players trying out for 25 places, and I made it through.

What's your biggest netball disappointment?

Losing an U15 Grand Final 3 years ago, especial as we lost to a team we had beaten twice during the season.

What makes you proud to belong to WSNC?

I've been here a long time, my friends are here, and I'm just happy to be with the Club.

Do you have a message to existing players?

I used to do athletics, and also used to be tall for my age, which really helped me at first with netball. But to keep playing, and to do well, you have to work at it by training & trying to improve your skills all the time. But most of all, you have to have fun.
