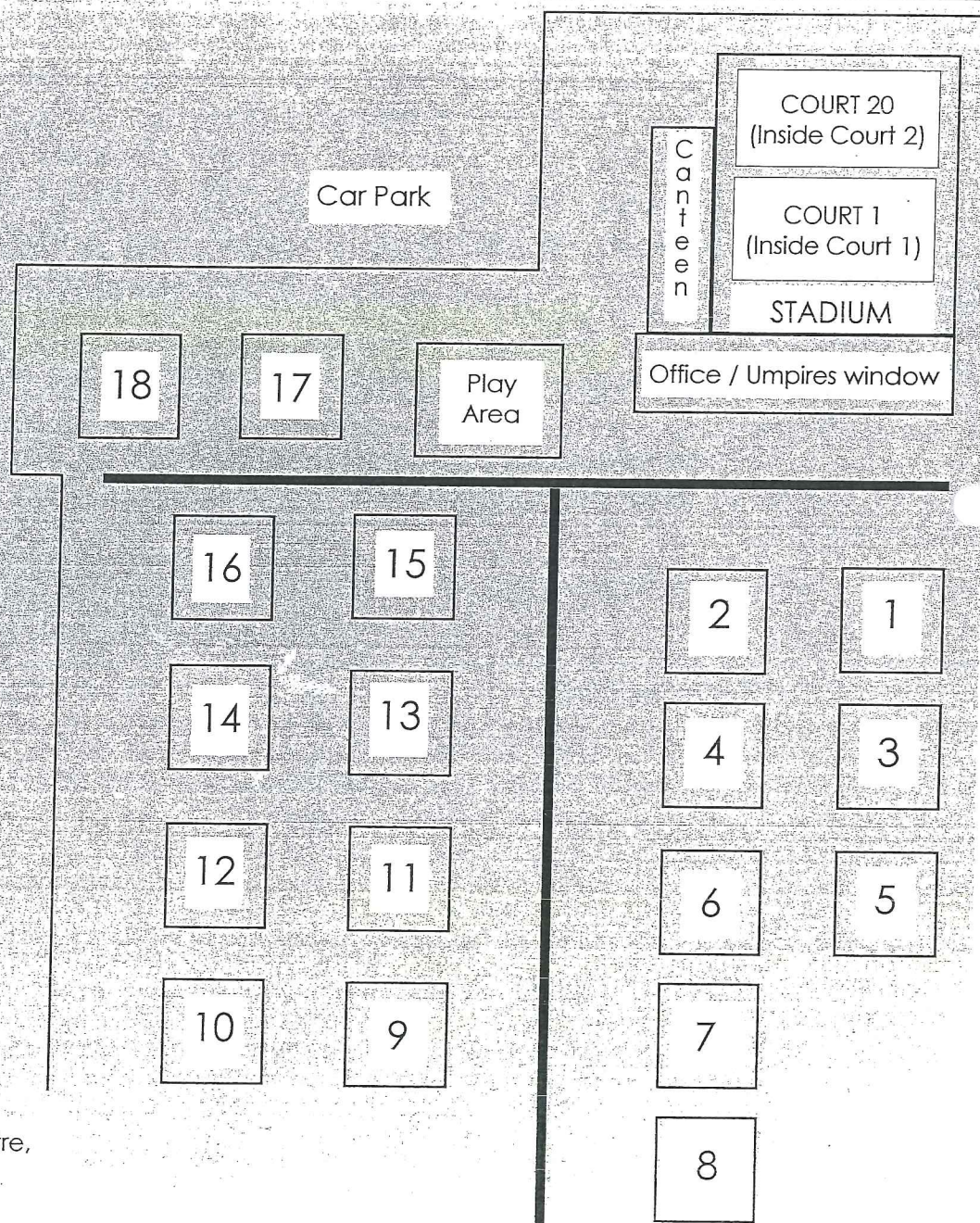

What's your overall philosophy on playing / coaching? Definitely to have fun.

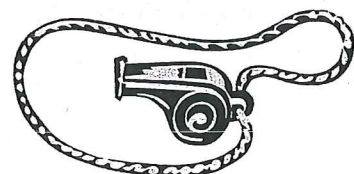
What's your greatest netball achievement?

We are very happy to advise that this year, all players and coaches will be given their tickets to the Presentation Night free of charge.

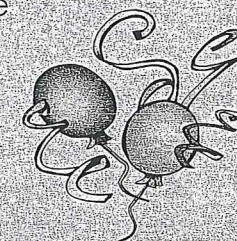
