

Gradings Info

All girls who will be playing in competitive sections in the coming season (13, 15, 17 & under; Open and A Grade) are required to attend our annual grading games. For those who are new to our club or new to 13's in 2007, we thought you may like to know more about how our Gradings are run at Wantirna South Netball Club.

At the end of every year, coaches are asked to provide Player Assessments; they know their players best and this information is invaluable. After player registrations are in as well, Match committee organise games ensuring ALL players have an opportunity to play in their first preferred position (as stated on their registration form), and usually in their second preferred as well. Many hours of thought and planning are put into gradings and team selection; however we cannot stress enough that <u>no decisions</u> on teams are made until after both the grading games. For this reason it's important for the players to make every effort to be there both weeks. But if you just can't make it then <u>please</u> let us know in advance, as a courtesy to both Match committee and other players, thank you ©

We hope to again have a combination of independent observers and our own A Grade & Open players, to assess and comment on the players' performances and effort during the games.

Then Match Committee meet to put it all together, taking into account the Coaches Player Assessments; team balance; performance at Grading Games; on-court positions; age and year level at school; and their own knowledge of the players among many other things, before hopefully coming up with the best combinations, and the right sections for them to play in.

We have learned a lot in the last two years since we moved to be "a grading club", and know absolutely that on-court success at the end of the season starts with doing the Gradings properly.

Teams are selected for the entire year, unless player registrations make changes necessary for Spring season.

Our gradings will be held on February 4th and 11th at the Knox Netball Centre, starting at 9:30am both days. Further details will be advised once we have finalised registrations.
