We've got a lot of new coaches this spring season, some are mums coaching for the first time and also a number of our young players have decided to give it a go.

We'd like to ask everyone - players, parents, grandparents, and spectators to give THEM a go! It isn't easy being a coach even when you're experienced, and like anything it takes time to learn. They'll make mistakes along the way but none of them will be fatal! Just remember that while you only have to worry about one player in a team, they have to worry about them all, and they're doing their best! Give them your support, they're the ones giving back to the club and to your kids!



# **SCORING**

Do you know how to score? We're all asked to do this from time to time but often no-one ever explains how to!

- First, home team scores! Ask someone from the opposition to fill in their own player positions prior to the game starting, and you record those for our team. Also record position changes to show any player who is off for the first quarter but plays 2nd or subsequent quarters. This is important to show the player took the court and may impact on qualifications for finals later.
- If a player is borrowed from another team they have to register at the office first, and you need to write their name on the front of the sheet too. Make sure you get their name right please!
- Once a player fills in once, their name will appear on all future sheets. <u>Don't</u> cross their name off, just put a line through all the quarters of the game to show they didn't participate in that game.

Once the game gets started:

- Record who has the centre pass, either by using H & A (for home & away team) or by using for example W & B (for Wantirna Sth & Boronia). It doesn't matter at all which method you use!
- Record which team scores a goal by marking either the GS or the GA, not essential that it be the right one.
- Record the goal on the running score
- Do all three in whatever order you like but it is MUCH easier to do what works for you. If its too confusing at first then don't worry about the centre pass, just concentrate on the score.
- Each quarter break add up the goals scored by each team and total in the column shown, and circle the running score. This helps as a cross-check and a marker for the end of each quarter. They of course need to tie up! But if they do then you have no problem, it will all add up at the end <sup>©</sup>. Thank you Scorers!!
